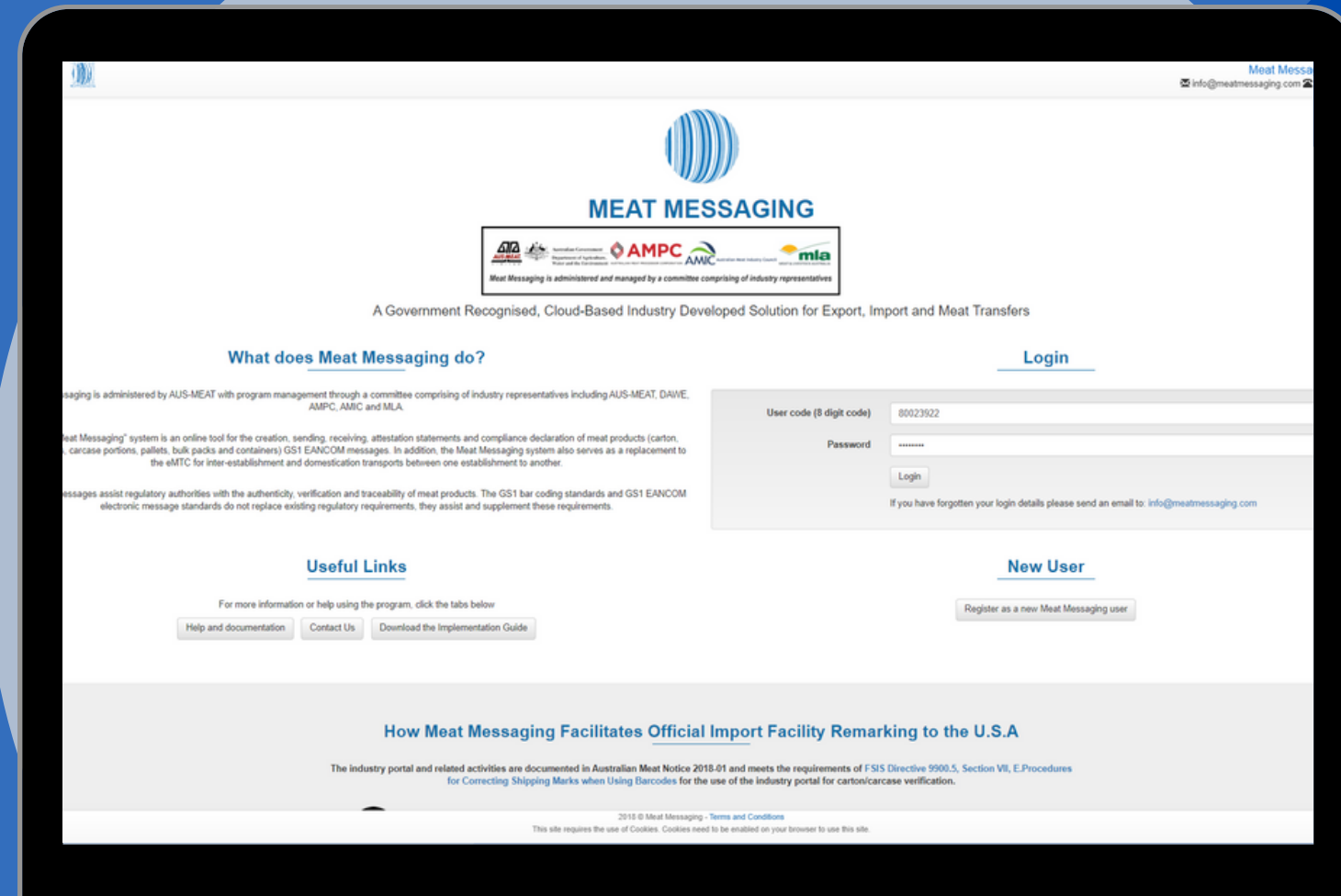






# Step 1: Login into your Meat Messaging Account
